Despite what many would consider to be a “small dog”, a healthy Corgi can grow up to weigh 20-30 pounds, and standing at just around 12 inches tall. Keeping this in mind, despite their stumpy legs and short stature, Corgis can easily knock over a small child or anyone with unsteady gait. Jumping up is a behavior that can be corrected or deterred with proper training. However, the body type, height, and figure of a Corgi is not something that can be changed through training and it is important to consider how this particular breed could easily be a “fall hazard” amongst certain individuals.\*

## **Application Terms, Fees, & Reservation Status**

We approve applicants based on the careful review and consideration of the information you provide within the Corgi Puppy Application and during our scheduled Zoom Interview. We are committed to ensuring forever homes for our puppies and strive to match each puppy with the most suitable applicant.

In the event your application is approved, you will be notified and a Reservation Fee of \$300 USD will be due within 24 hours of receiving notification of approval. Once the Reservation Fee has been received you will be placed onto our Reservation List in the order in which your Corgi Puppy Application was received.

Our Reservation List is limited to the number of puppies within the available litter. Our Corgi Puppy Application is not a rolling application and therefore is only opened to the public when a pregnancy is confirmed in our Crew. The application will no longer be available once the Reservation List is filled . It is important for our applicants to consider the gestation period and the

appropriate age in which puppies are usually sent home with their forever family. Gestation is roughly 55-68 days. Once the puppies are born, based on the projected timeline of natural mother-led weaning, preventative deworming, and the initial dose of recommended vaccinations; most puppies are ready to go to their forever homes by 8-10 weeks of age. Therefore, depending upon the date in which your application is submitted, you must be prepared to bring home your Corgi puppy at any time within 4 months of submitting your application.
